

U.S. AbilityOne Commission to hold public meeting at 2019 American Foundation for the Blind Leadership Conference in Arlington, Va., on Feb. 28

In a first, the U.S. AbilityOne Commission will hold its regular quarterly public meeting at the 2019 American Foundation for the Blind Leadership Conference, in Arlington, Va., from 3-5 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 28. Commission Chairperson Thomas D. Robinson will lead the meeting, with reports and updates provided by Executive Director Tina Ballard, the Central Nonprofit Agencies, and others.
