

U.S. AbilityOne Commission to Hold Quarterly Public Meeting on February 10, 2022

WASHINGTON, D.C., January 10, 2022 – The U.S. AbilityOne Commission will hold its regular quarterly public meeting on February 10, 2022, from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. Commission Chairperson Jeffrey A. Koses will lead the meeting, with reports and updates from Acting Executive Director Kim Zeich and others.

The meeting will be conducted virtually because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Attendees may register at the link posted in the news section of the Commission's homepage at www.abilityone.gov by 11:59 p.m. EDT on Tuesday, February 8, 2022. Registration will generate an email to the attendee containing the Zoom link for the meeting.

The Commission is committed to public meetings that provide transparency and substantive information as it implements new strategies and priorities. These meetings also provide an opportunity for input from the disability community and other stakeholders.

For the meeting on February 10, 2022, the Commission invites comments or suggestions regarding:

- 1. The Individual Eligibility Evaluation (IEE) forms used by the Commission as documentation of significant disability.
- 2. Third party certification or verification of significant disability.

Those interested in submitting comments, or requesting speaking time, may do so as part of registering for the meeting. (Commenters should avoid including any information that they do not want publicly disclosed.) Comments submitted via the registration link will be reviewed by the Commission prior to the meeting. The Commission may invite some attendees who submit advance comments to speak to their comments during the meeting. Comments posted in the chat box during the meeting will be shared with Commission members as time permits.
